COVID-19 PREPAREDNESS PLAN

- 1 Advise all guests (not from the same room) to adhere to the 6' social distancing rules
- 2 Provide non-medical grade face protectors to all employees
- 3 Make cleaning supplies available to staff and provide time to wash hands frequently
- 4 Increase facility cleaning and disinfecting in rooms and common areas plus the pool house
- 5 Protocols have been adopted to disinfect areas if a positive case has of Covid-19 has been identified
- 6 If any staff member tests positive for Covid-19, that person shall notify the Gray Wolf Management, the local health department and any co-workers that they have been in contact with
- Any staff member displaying symptoms of Covid-19 will need to get tested and a negative test will be needed to return to work
- 8 Sick employees will be strongly encouraged to stay home

SWIMMING POOL

According to the CDC, the Covid-19 virus cannot be spread to people through the water in swimming pools or hot tubs.

However 6' of social distancing rules will be enforced while in the pool house.

Until further notice the swimming pool capacity will be reduced to 25% of capacity per the Governors Executed Order #2020-115. This allows the Gray Wolf Lodge to only allow 7 people in our swimming pool.

The pool will be monitored by the manager on duty. Social distancing signs and

reduced pool capacity signs will be posted in the pool area.

LMAS Health Department recommdations to "Prevent the Spread of Covid-19" will be posted in the pool area.

The Gray Wolf Lodge would like to assure our guests that we are taking precautions to moderate the spread of Covid-19. Our staff is working hard to clean and sanitize rooms and common areas. With social distancing and a little common sense, we hope that all of our Guests have a comfortable and pleasant stay.
